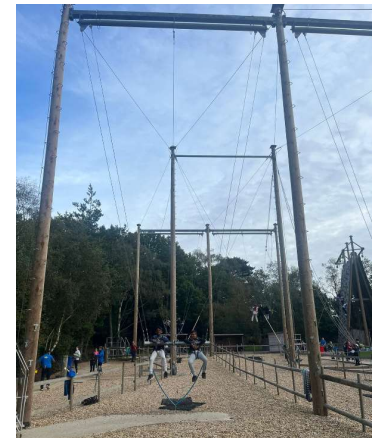
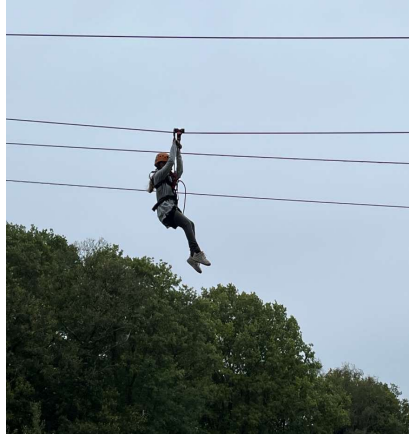

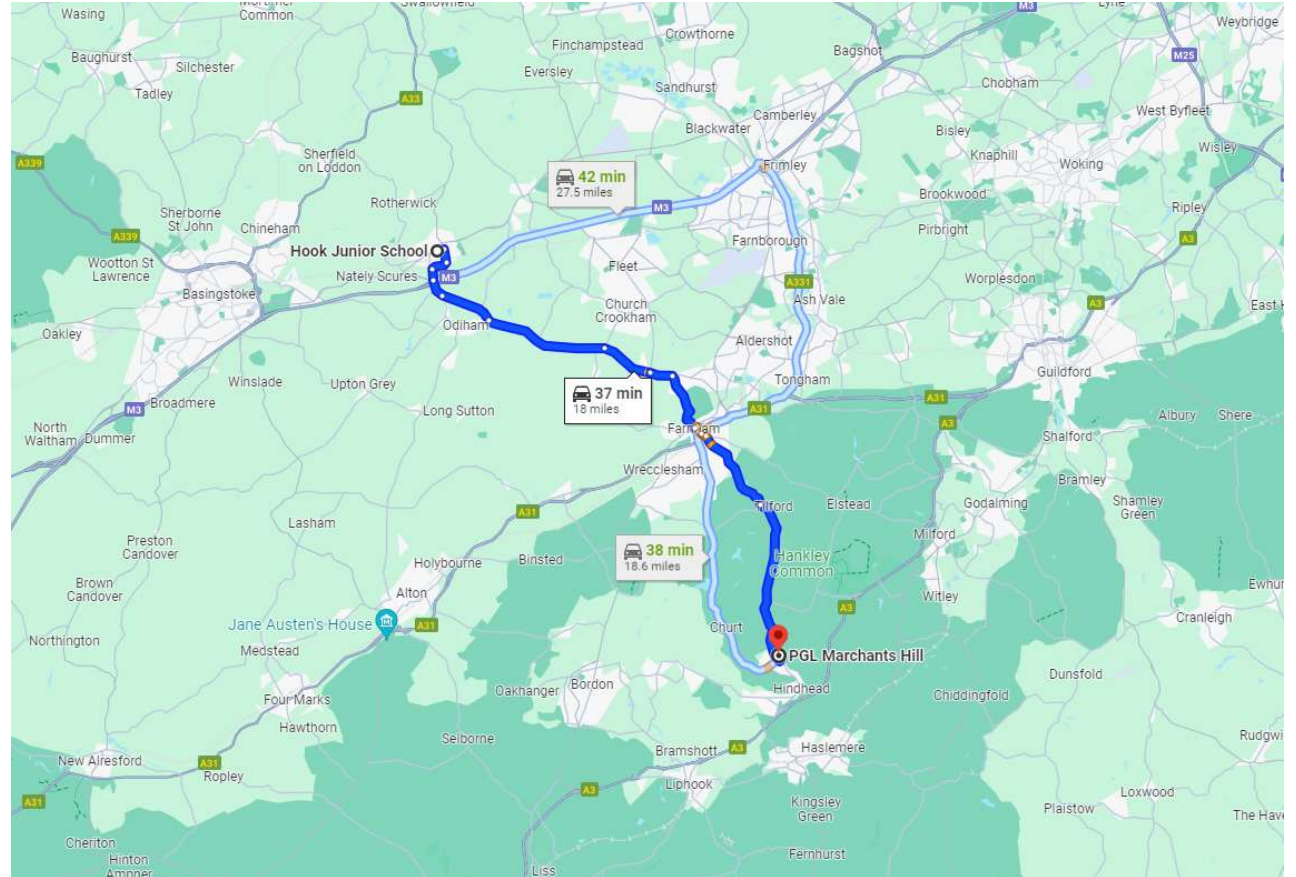

Accommodation

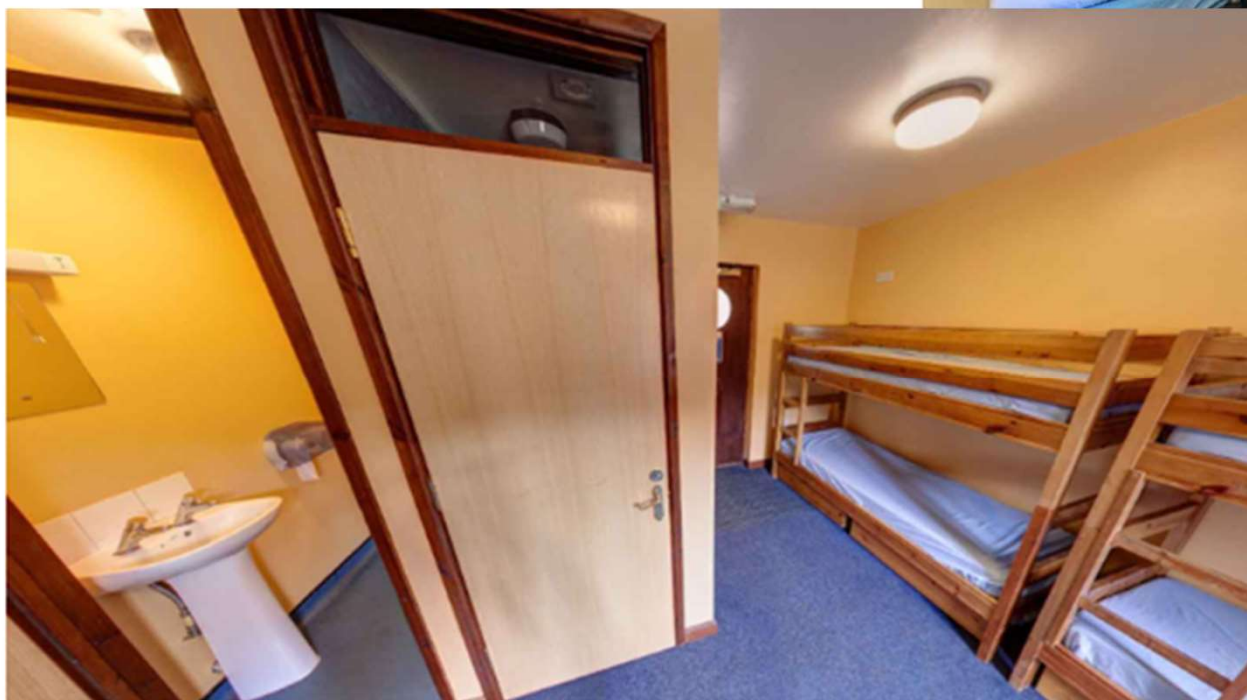
- Purpose-built lodges

Schedule	Activities
07.00 - 08.50	Get up, get ready and fuel up for the day ahead with a hearty breakfast.
08.50 - 12.00	Morning activities - 2 sessions with a 10 minute break in-between.
12.00 - 13.50	Enjoy a fresh and tasty two-course hot lunch and some free time.
13.50 - 17.00	Afternoon activities - 2 sessions with a 10 minute break in-between.
17.00 - 19.00	Time to eat again - a different dinner menu each day.
19.00 - 21.00	1 hour of activities - discos, campfires, quizzes and more - our evening activity programme keeps everyone engaged until bedtime.
21.00 / 21.30	Bedtime. Catch up on some zzz's ready to do it all again tomorrow!

- To keep your children energised during their active break, the PGL catering team provide a menu jam-packed with fresh, nutritious meals.
- PGL operate a buffet style dining room, meaning children can ‘mix and match’ the items of their choice and have unlimited access to a salad bar and fresh fruit.
- PGL Group leaders are on hand to help and will look out for anyone who can’t find anything on the menu that they enjoy. If necessary, the catering team are more than happy to prepare something special.
- Allergies, intolerances and other dietary requirements:
A vegetarian alternative can always be provided on and they will accommodate most special diets required on medical or religious grounds.
- Keeping hydrated:
Water and squash are available with all meals and children are encouraged to refill their water bottles for regular use throughout the day. There are also water fountains available around the center.

Important Information



Date of trip - Monday 21st - 25th October 2024

Cost - The total cost of the residential trip is £395 per child which covers:

- 4 nights' accommodation,
- Full board mealtimes (a hot breakfast, lunch and dinner - offering as much as a child wants to eat)
- Full day and evening itinerary of enriching activities that children will participate in (Daytime activities from 8.50-5.10pm and evening activities from 7-8.30pm).
- Activities lead by qualified and experienced PGL instructors
- Use of PGL equipment and resources

We will require an initial **deposit of £50 per child payable by 15th December 2023.**

There will be another meeting at the start of the autumn term in 2024, where you will be given further details about the trip.

Travel Arrangements

- We are considering re-introducing a coach service to transport all pupils to and from the school to the site in Hindhead.
- The cost of this would be £17.50 per child. This would not be a mandatory payment however, we would request a voluntary contribution per child to cover the cost of the coaches. Providing the coach service would only be possible with a significant level of contributions; if we do not receive voluntary contributions per child we will not be able to provide the coaches and will ask that parents transport children to and from Marchants Hill as is currently the arrangement.
- We welcome your view on whether you would like the school to provide this coach service and whether you would be willing to contribute the cost of providing this service. We would therefore be grateful if you could complete the survey which will be sent out separately via ParentMail. A decision will be communicated in January 2024.
