Revised Coronavirus operational measures

We emailed all parents at the start of this week explaining the revised arrangements in response to the emergence of the Omicron coronavirus variant.

We are reviewing and updating our measures to reflect new guidance as it becomes available and anticipate that these are temporary changes to existing and ongoing safety measures. It is imperative we continue to aim to reduce the disruption to our children and their education and the priority for all schools remains to deliver face-to-face high-quality education to all pupils.

<u>Guidance on when to self isolate is published by the NHS</u>. You will be advised by NHS test and trace if you have been a close contact of someone who has received a positive PCR test result. This will include any specific testing and isolation guidance, including for the Omicron variant.

We ensure that areas of school well ventilated throughout the day. As the outside temperature in autumn and winter is much colder, ventilation is balanced with the need to provide a comfortable teaching environment. CO2 monitors are being used to help us identify any areas where additional ventilation may be necessary.

Staff and visitors are all now required to wear face masks when moving around in corridors and communal areas.

We already have established hygiene and cleaning processes in school and these will continue to be applied.

School staff continue to take lateral flow tests twice a week at home. There is no requirement for primary age pupils to take weekly lateral flow tests. If your child has symptoms or you are concerned about contact with a suspected or confirmed case, we encourage you to follow appropriate testing guidance and also to let us know if your child is unable to attend school for any reason, including - and most importantly - when the absence is related to coronavirus.

We appreciate your continued support and will update you with any further updates as they arise.

Note that we are not issuing paper tickets this year and will instead verify your ticket purchase on arrival. Audience members will receive a programme to take home.

Christmas celebrations have already started in school and just before the end of term we are delighted to resume our annual 'Carols around the Tree' event. Children are already rehearsing their music and are eager to share their work with the community.

We anticipate being able to make a limited number of further tickets available closer to the event, however this will be subject to any change in coronavirus guidance that we might receive and a suitable safety risk assessment. 
