To be able to access Wheeler's e-Platform site [ePlatform](#) you will need the following:

A valid login - student username & password

Internet access

A compatible device to read an e-Book on or listen to

**Apple devices (eg. iPhone, iPad or iPod Touch (requires iOS7 or higher))**

Download the app from [Apple App Store](#).

**Android devices (eg. Galaxy Tab, Galaxy S, Galaxy Note, HTC devices)**

Download the app from [Google Play](#).

**Windows tablets (NOT Windows phones)**

Download the app from [Windows store](#).

**Desktop or laptop (PC or Mac)**



Read via your browser or download reader software and create an Adobe ID. See our [guide to setting this up](#).

Download the correct app for your device, or alternatively use the web address : [WWW.eplatform.co/uk](http://WWW.eplatform.co/uk), choose find libraries and type in Hook Junior School. This will take you to a homepage where you can then login.

Click on Sign In – using your Login & Password given to you

You are ready to browse the e-Platform site. If you wish, you can use the additional filters at the side of the page to narrow your search of books down.

To browse the books you can click on the blue Start Browsing tab or use the black tool bar at the top of the page.

To read the blurb from the book click on the cover to borrow the book click on the blue borrow tab.

Select read and the book will be available to read when connected to Wi-Fi.





Downloading EAudio:




### Downloading eBooks:
