Year 3 Hook Local Study Trip



This week the Year 3's have enjoyed their outing to their local area of Hook. They began their trip by conducting a traffic survey along London Road counting all the vehicles, which passed by for a duration of 10 minutes. We then continued down London Road looking at the types and styles of buildings from residential to commercial to terrace to detached houses in addition to visiting the local church. Each child then completed an environmental quality survey of the centre of Hook and will analyse their data during their follow up geography lessons. On the way home, the children visited Wellworth Park to discuss the purpose of why two parks are very closely situated and the importance of green space in the local area. The children were very excited to be out of school and enjoyed their outdoor learning experience.

To help keep them safe, please ensure that your child wears a helmet if they travel to school on their scooter or bike.


KOOSA Kids - Holiday Activity & Food (HAF) Programme
