With the end of the year fast approaching, please can we ask any parents with medicine at school to come and collect it from the school office before next Friday.

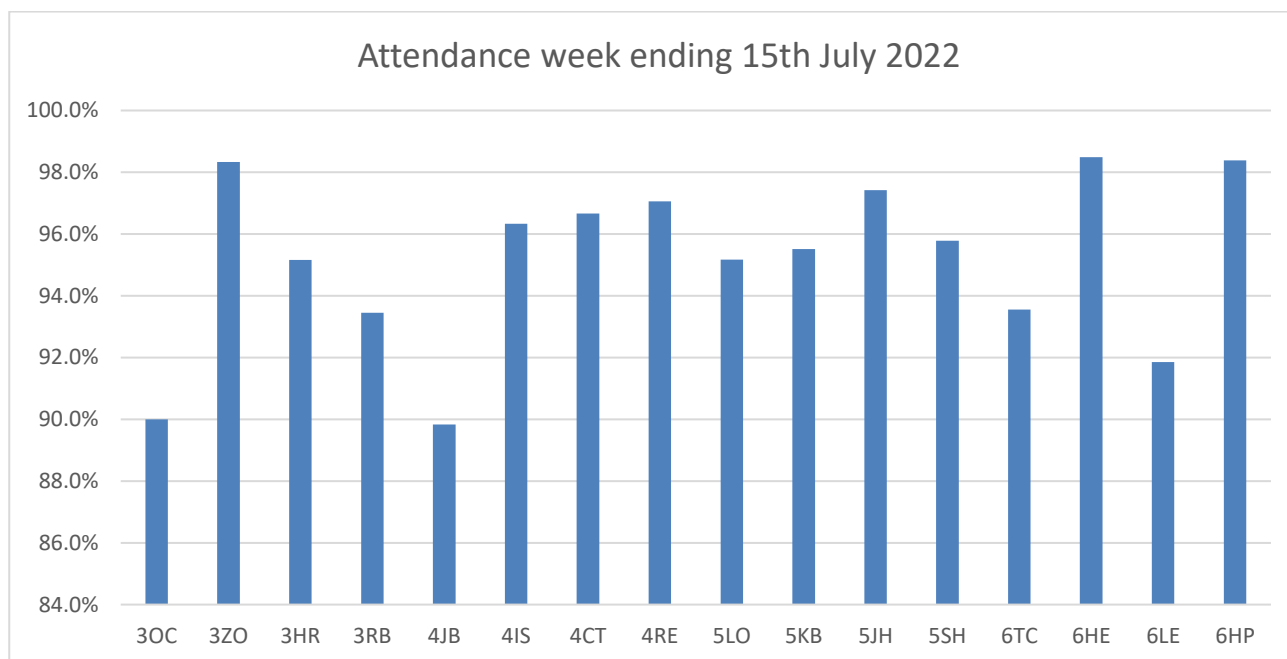
## KOOSA Kids - Holiday Activity & Food (HAF) Programme

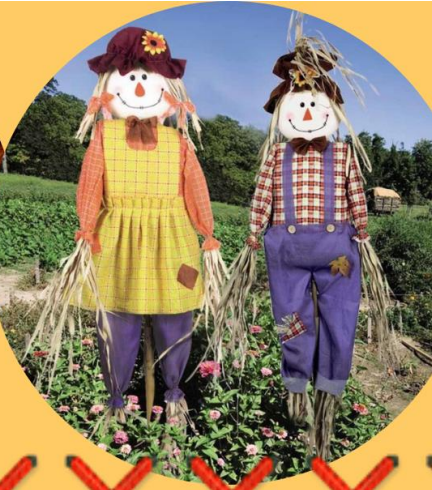
