Attendance

As a school, attendance continues to be a key focus not only at a national level but also for our own school. As a result, we have a named Senior Leader, Miss Carne, who has a responsibility to oversee attendance across the school. If any parent/carer is experiencing any difficulties around attendance or lateness, please contact Miss Carne at the earliest opportunity so that she can discuss with you your particular circumstances.

We are currently finalising our Attendance Strategy document for this year and will be sharing this with parents over the next few weeks.

As you will be aware, a child's attendance (and absence) is a legal parental

responsibility. Children at this school are dependent on their parents/carers, who are responsible for their level of attendance and punctuality. It is vital that children enjoy coming to school, and whilst being encouraged to attend well and on time, children do not carry blame for their own attendance or lateness.

What should I do if my child is going to be absent from school?

Our main priority first thing in the morning, is always to establish that every child is safe and attending school.

Parents/carers have a responsibility to inform the school as soon as possible if their child will not be attending school or is likely to be late on a particular day, by no later than 9 am. This can be done via either sending an email to <u>adminoffice@hook-jun.hants.sch.uk</u> or ringing the attendance line and leaving a message.

Messages about absences should include the child's name, their class and a clear reason for absence. We ask that parents are not vague with their reasons e.g., 'not well' as this will not be authorised until further detail is clarified. For these parents, the admin staff or the Attendance Leader (Miss Carne) will ring in order to establish a more acceptable reason for absence.

If children are absent with for example anxiety or not sleeping at night, the Attendance Lead will ring these parents/carers in order to help remove barriers for these children coming into school.

Uniform

We know that some uniform products supplied by Marks and Spencer are currently difficult to obtain and we thank you for your patience at this time of peak demand. Products are slowly getting back to normal supply levels and in the meantime, please simply ensure that your child arrives at school wearing the non-branded elements of the uniform. If you wish, do send your child to school in a plain navy jumper or cardigan in lieu of the items bearing the school logo. School portrait photographs will be taken on Wednesday 21 September, so please ensure that your child is smartly dressed and well presented for this, in accordance with our uniform expectations.

Paying for School Meals

We encourage all parents to pay for school meals using the online Scopay portal or app. It's a simple means of paying for meals in advance without the need to deliver cash to the school office. If your child is in year 4, 5 or 6 then you should already have access to Scopay. Letters have been sent home with year 3 pupils this week so that you can access and top-up their account where necessary. 

Attendance




