


## Topic Books for Year 5 Summer



Full of interesting facts about Ancient Greece, each page focuses on a specific topic and includes information about three sub-topics, source material and images, a glossary, and suggested words to use.







Who were the ancient Greeks? What are the Greek myths? What food did people eat? When were the first Olympic games?
