Diarrhoea and Vomiting

There have been several cases in school recently of children suffering with diarrhoea and vomiting and we have been made aware that this is also the case across the county.

The critical elements to manage and prevent onward transmission are:

- Good hand hygiene
- Prompt exclusion from school
- Pupil not to return until they are 48 hours free from symptoms

- It is also strongly recommended that individuals who have had a bout of cryptosporidiosis infection are not allowed to go to a swimming pool until 14 days after the last diarrhoeal episode.

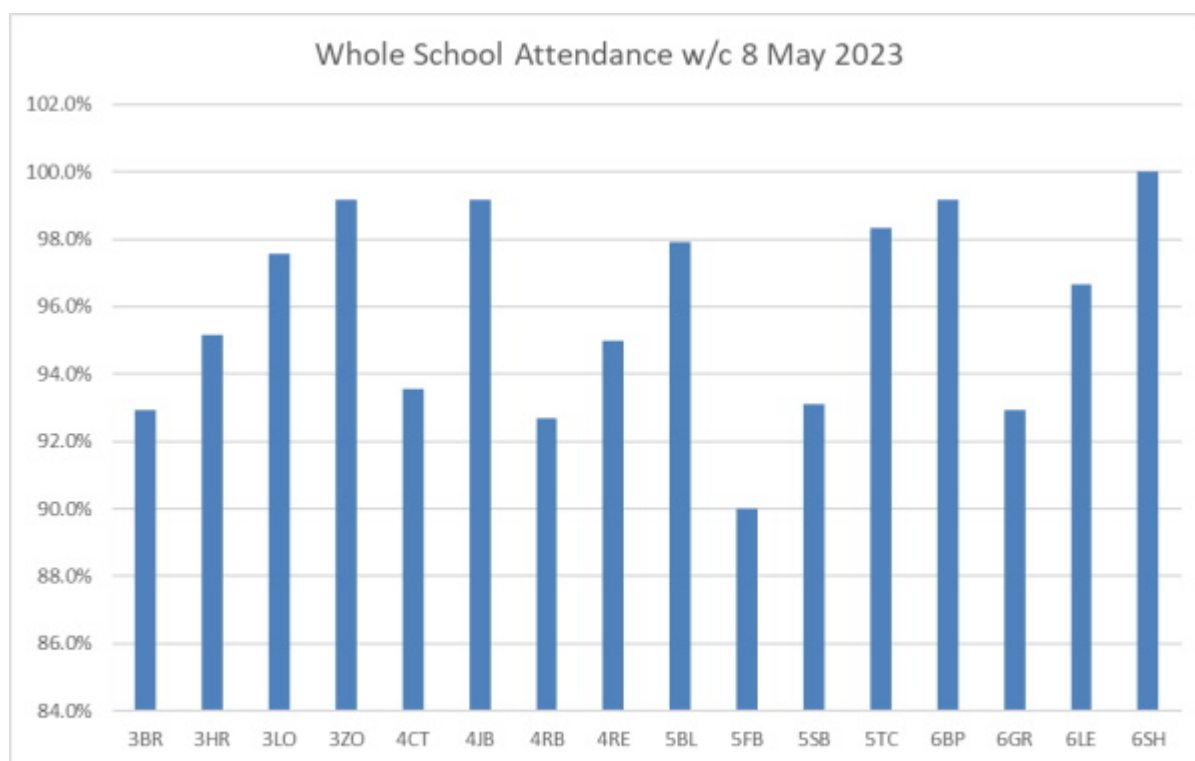
