

Whole School Attendance this week: 97%

On Thursday, it was lovely to see whole school attendance at 98.6% with several classes hitting 100%. Indeed, so far this year, the average overall attendance for the school is 97.2% which currently puts us in the 91st percentile against other schools nationally.

With this pleasing data in mind, we would like to remind parents and carers that if you have any concerns about your child's attendance then they should contact Miss Carne via the school office at the earliest opportunity.

Democracy - UK Parliament Visitor

On Thursday this week we had a visit from Kerrie Carpenter, an Engagement Outreach Officer working for the UK Parliament. Her presentation to the whole school included an understanding of how UK Parliament works, the roles and responsibilities of MPs and members of the House of Lords as well as how they could get their voices heard.

Kerrie is the first of our planned visitors to help develop the children's knowledge around the concept of democracy. In early November, we look forward to welcoming a councillor from Hart District Council who will be coming to talk about his role and the election process. These visitors along with all children being involved in our own School Council elections, will lead to an increased understanding of democracy in action at a national, local and school level.

Applying for a Secondary School Place

There are just over three weeks left for parents to apply for secondary school places for children due to start Year 7 in September 2024. The deadline is Tuesday 31 October.

This year the County Council is running drop-in sessions at libraries for parents who require support with their applications. These are on the following dates:

Parents are being reminded to name three schools to give them the best chance of securing a place at one of their preferred schools. If you have already submitted your application but haven't listed three schools, you can still log back into the <u>School Admissions system</u> at any time to update your application before the deadline.

Parents yet to apply can now <u>go online</u>, or alternatively request paper forms by emailing <u>admissions.team@hants.gov.uk</u>.

Parents who applied online and on time will be notified of the outcome of their application on 1 March 2024, and two to three working days later by letter if they applied using a paper form.

Travelling Books pay a small commission return to us after the book sale which we invest in new stock for our library and books that are used as reading raffle prizes.
