We will be putting on a couple of movie afternoons, first one being Wednesday 14th August, in our courtyard.

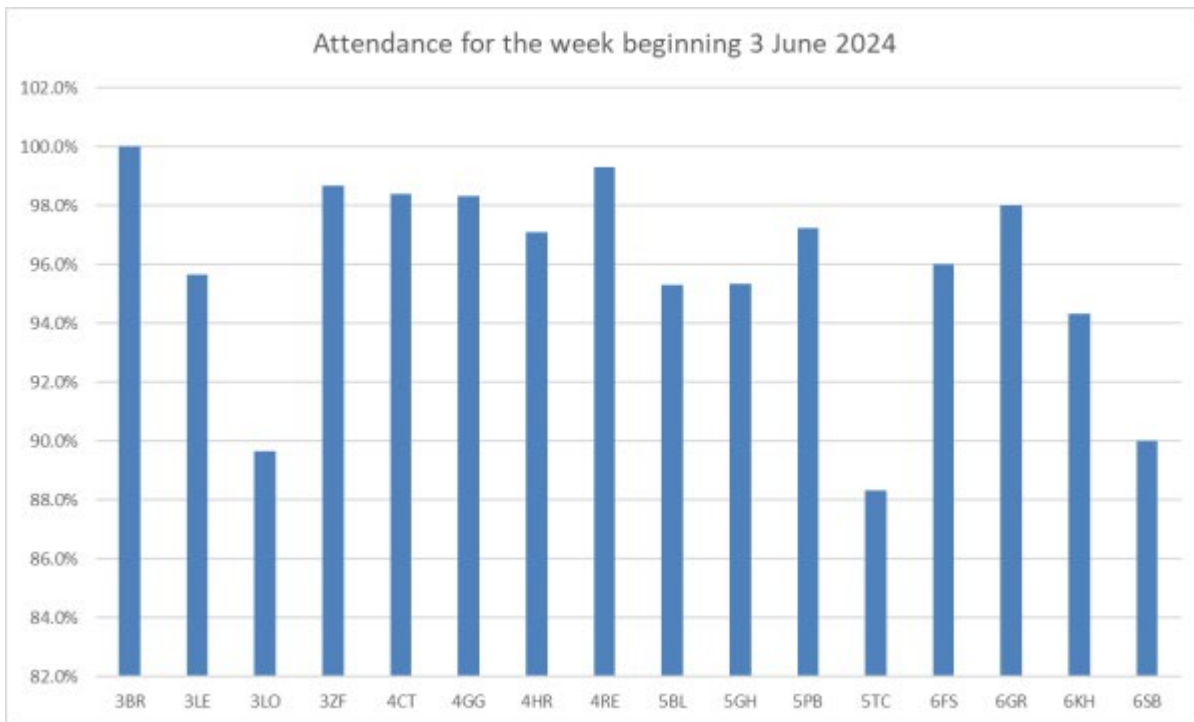
